What do local refugee support groups do?

Skipton Group and Refugee ReSETTLEment directly support refugees who live in Skipton and Settle using volunteers.

All the groups:

- Fundraise for refugees and refugee organisations
- Undertake collections of toiletries and sanitary products, food, household goods, laptops and phones, bicycles and clothing
- Host welcome days and visits to the countryside.
- Provide information (leaflets, factsheets and presentations) about refugees.
- Campaign for the better treatment of refugees in the UK.

We work closely with BIASAN, Abigail Housing, Pendle New Neighbours, City of Sanctuary.

Each group supports refugees in their own way and the Network promotes activities, fundraises and campaigns together.
